Vermilion County, Illinois has property tax inquiry and mobile home tax information on-line by purchasing a yearly subscription for \$75.00.

If an organization is a member of the Danville Board of Realty there is no charge since the Danville Board of Realty pays a lump sum for all their members once a year. (They will need to call the Danville Board of Realty to get their user name and password.)

Locate the **Treasurer - Tax Inquiry** on the right hand portion of the screen

The program allows for inquiry on property tract records by entering the first few characters of a tract number, owner name (Last Name, First Name Ex: Smith, John), mailing address, property address, legal description, previous owner and p.i.n. number.

The screen will then display a table of matching records. To view a record, simply put the mouse on the desired record and click. The individual property tax record will be displayed with all the current information. This includes: the tract number, owner name, bill number, amount due, legal description, mailing address, property address, legal description, amount paid, and many other fields.

The tax information is updated nightly, so all information is current.

If you cannot get onto the Tax Inquiry program, try the following:

- a. Reboot your pc
- b. Update your Internet Explorer to Internet Explorer 6.0 using the Microsoft Windows Updates.
- c. Do **NOT** save the Tax Inquiry web page as your favorite, instead save the Vermilion County web-site.
- d. Turn off your pop-up blocker to allow access to the Vermilion County web-site.
