The two Commissioners present signed the abstracts and it was noted that Charles Bostic would sign the following day.

It was reported that the AECOI spring conference would be held in Collinsville, Illinois on May 10, 11 & 12, 2006 at the Holiday Inn. East St. Louis Election Commission will host the event. No agenda had been received as of this date.
