### Approval of Agenda

### Accounts Payable – purchase orders

Barbara Dreher explained purchase orders in the total amount of \$7,386.60 and stated that the invoice from Election Systems and Software for the March 21, 2006 Primary Election is under negotiation as the amount billed is incorrect. Betty Seidel moved to accept for payment the purchase orders as presented. Barbara Bailey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

### Legal matters

Attorney, Dave Ryan stated that the recount hearing for the April 2005 Newell Township Road Commissioner would be held at 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, September 20, 2006 in the Vermilion County Courthouse Chambers of Associate Judge Joseph Skowronski.

It was also stated that a hearing was being held in Springfield, Illinois on September 19, 2006 as to whether the name of Joe Parnarauskis would be placed on the November 7, 2006 ballot as Socialist Equality Party candidate for Senator of the 52<sup>nd</sup> District.

### Voter Registration System – Update

Barbara Dreher explained that she had received the list of State requirements for the voter registration system and had forwarded it to Karen Rudd of the Vermilion County Technology Services and would be working with Karen and Ted Fisher in this matter. She also explained that one big factor is the County approval of the purchase of the new updated County technology system requested by the County Technology Services.

### **County/Commission Budget Update**

Barbara Dreher updated the Commissioners on the status of the Election Commission 2006-2007 budget. The final approval of the budget will be presented to the full County Board on October 10, 2006 at 6:00 p.m.
