MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING February 16, 2010

Call to Order, Minutes and Agenda:

The regular meeting of the Danville Election Commission was called to order by Chairman Barbara Bailey at 9:00AM on Tuesday, February 16, 2010, with Executive Director Barbara Dreher and Commissioners Charles Bostic and Everett Laury also present. Unanimously approved were the proposed agenda for this meeting and the minutes for the previous January 12, 2010 meeting.

Accounts Payable:

Payment for bills for the period of January 6 through February 8, 2010 in the amount of \$8952.07 were unanimously approved, with the largest bill being for publication of election notices in the amount of \$5491.47.

Voter Registration:

For January 2010, voter registrations totaling 221 were received, with 123 being new registrations. The largest source of the registrations was 91 from Public Aid.

Voter Fraud Case:

There is no additional information on the alleged voter fraud matter, and the State's Attorney office will again be contacted.

Election Matters:

The present cost of the Primary Election is \$53,406.49, with final bill from ES&S and for a rental truck yet to be received. Two screens went down during the election and the warranty for repairs is being investigated. Director Dreher has looked into purchasing a program to accomplish repairs at the office but the \$10,000 cost and \$3,000 yearly maintenance fee might be too expensive.


AECOI Conference:

Director Dreher reported that reservations are coming in for the May 2010 AECOI Conference that Danville is hosting. A suggestion was made that a representative from the Illinois Attorney General's Office be invited to talk on new election laws. Also that a representative from the Vermilion County Museum talk on Uncle Joe Cannon. Sponsors are being sought to help on food expenses and for "goody bags" to be given out at the registration table. Also possible meeting topics were discussed.

Adjournment:

The meeting was adjourned at 10:17AM, with the final election canvass to follow. The next regular meeting is scheduled for 9:00AM on March 9, 2010.
