I state that I am a resident of the precinct and county specified above, that I have lived at said address for 30 days or more preceding this election, that I am lawfully entitled to vote in such precinct at said election to be held therein.

Grace Period Registrant (I have registered or transferred my registration during the period of 27 - 7 days prior to the election at the office of the election authority or a designated location). I understand that applying for, and casting, an early ballot means that I cannot vote at the polling place on election day.

Early Voter I am casting a ballot during the period of 22 - 5 days prior to the election. I understand that applying for, and casting, an early ballot means that I cannot vote at the polling place on election day.

I hereby make application for an official ballot or ballots to be voted by me at such election and agree that I shall return the ballot or ballots to the election official issuing the same prior to the closing of the polls on the date of the election or, if returned by mail, **postmarked no later than midnight preceding election day**, for counting no later than during the period for counting provisional ballots, the last day of which is the 14th day following election day.

Under penalties as provided by law pursuant to 10 ILCS 5/29-10, the undersigned certifies that the statements set forth in this application are true and correct.

NOTICE TO ABSENTEE VOTERS

Unless you are a voter who has become hospitalized within 5 days of the election, or a resident of a soldier and sailors home, only you or your spouse, parent, child, brother or sister or a representative of a company engaged in the business and making deliveries to the election authority may take your ballot and ballot card envelope for deposit into the mail.

TO THE VOTER: In signing the certification on the absentee ballot envelope, you are attesting that you personally marked this absentee ballot in secret. If you are physically unable to mark the ballot, a friend or relative may assist you after completing the affidavit on the front of the ballot envelope.

TO THE PERSON PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO VOTERS: You have been selected by a voter to provide voting assistance. Under Illinois law, only voters who are blind, physically disabled or unable to read or write the English language may be assisted by a relative or friend. **Individuals who cannot assist voters include the voter's employer or agent of that employer or officer or agent of the voter's union.**

You must mark the ballot as directed by the voter. Individuals who make any attempt to influence the voter's choice of candidates, party or votes in relation to a public question, or mark the ballot other than directed by the voter may be guilty of a felony. If you cannot tell the voter's intent, you must not mark the ballot in any way. You may not subsequently divulge the candidate(s) or public questions for whom the voter instructed you to cast ballots.
