

TRAP NEUTER RETURN and OUTDOOR CATS

In keeping with guidance from The National Animal Care and Control Association (NACA), we are no longer admitting healthy outdoor cats to this facility. We will instead work with you to provide the cats with medical care and return them to their original location using a proven process called TNR (trap/neuter/return).

Why TNR?

- Sterilized, vaccinated cats make good neighbors. They fight less and provide a vaccination barrier between pets and wildlife.
- Removing outdoor cats does nothing to reduce population size in the long term.
- Admitting healthy outdoor cats reduces our ability to respond to critical needs in our community.

Ask us for assistance with your outdoor cats. Please do not bring them in! The best way we can help you, the cats, and our entire community is to TNR.
