DRIVER IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Circuit Court of Vermilion County and Danville Area Community College are proud to offer a Driver Improvement Program. The course was created by the National Safety Council and will be conducted by certified instructors from Cannon Cochran Management Services, Inc. of Danville.

To fulfill the obligations of your court supervision, please follow the instructions below:

ENROLLMENT

It is your responsibility to contact the DACC Corporate and Community Education Division, (217) 443- 8777, within 5 (five) days of the date court supervision was granted and enroll in a class. When you call to enroll, you will be advised as to when the next class offering is scheduled. You will be notified at the time of your enrollment as to the location on the DACC campus of your class.

FEE

There is a \$35 fee for the Driver Improvement Program, payable in either cash or money order (no personal checks), **DUE ON THE DAY OF CLASS**. Make money orders payable to Danville Area Community College. No one will be permitted to attend the program without payment of the course fee. This fee covers all necessary workbooks, supplies, and related materials.

ATTENDANCE

Participants must attend the entire 4 hour program. Failure to do so will negate the terms of your court supervision.

PROGRAM COMPLETION

Upon your successful completion of the Driver Improvement Program, you will be awarded a Certificate from the National Safety Council. More importantly, documentation of your successful completion will be placed in your court file, acknowledging your adherence to the requirements of the court supervision. Failure to complete the course will result in the State's Attorney bringing your case back to court.
