

# Ordinance

## Re: Solid Waste

**Whereas**, certain sections of the Health Department's Solid Waste ordinance are in need of amendment; and

**Whereas**, those amendments would aid in the enforcement of the ordinance; and

**Whereas**, the sections sought to be amended are set out below, with the original ordinance attached.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED THAT THE VERMILION COUNTY SOLID WASTE ORDINANCE** is hereby amended in the words and section numbers set out below:

2.1. J Other refuse shall be interpreted to mean bottles, tin cans, broken glass, crockery, household garbage, plastic containers, scrap metal, vehicle parts, derelict vehicles, printed matter, paper, discarded clothing, furniture, appliances, ashes and debris from fire damage, materials resulting from the construction, remodeling, repair or demolition of structures such as wood, wall coverings, plaster, drywall, plumbing fixtures, roofing shingles and other roof coverings, electrical wiring, and any other material which has been discarded, abandoned or otherwise disposed of improperly. This does not include earth, sand, brick, stone, plaster or other substances that may accumulate during the construction of a building.

11.2 No person shall violate any provision of this ordinance or abatement orders made in pursuance thereof, obstruct or interfere with the execution of an abatement order, or willfully neglect to obey an abatement order.

## SECTION XII-PENALTIES

12.1 A violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, excluding Section 8 where penalties are otherwise provided by law, is a petty offense punishable by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense as provided by law. Each day the violation continues shall constitute a separate offense. Offenders may also be ordered to abate the violation by demolishing uninhabitable buildings and by removing building remains, solid waste and other refuse to a state-licensed landfill or scrapyard.
