

ORDINANCE**RE: Depositing material on County Highway prohibited**

WHEREAS, the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois supervision of the County Highways; and,

WHEREAS, it is unlawful to throw, or leave debris upon a highway and such debris may be a safety hazard; and,

WHEREAS, the adoption of an ordinance, modeled on State law would allow for either an ordinance violation or State citation at the officer's discretion and will materially aid in the safety of the public and condition of the roadways.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois, that the ordinance is adopted as set forth below:

Depositing material on highway prohibited.

(a) No person shall throw, spill or deposit upon any highway any bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans, or any litter (as defined in Section 3 of the Illinois Litter Control Act).

(b) Any person who violates subsection (a) upon any highway shall immediately remove such material or cause it to be removed.

(c) Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a highway shall remove any glass or other debris, except any hazardous substance as defined in Section 3.215 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, hazardous waste as defined in Section 3.220 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, and potentially infectious medical waste as defined in Section 3.360 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, dropped upon the highway from such vehicle.


(d) A violation of this section shall be a petty offense and subject to a fine of \$100.00.
