RE: CHANGE IN POLLING PLACE

WHEREAS, the Vermilion County Board is required to provide suitable polling places for all elections; and,

WHEREAS, the owners of the previous polling place for Middlefork Township Precinct 2 Armstrong-Potomac High School, have determined that it is no longer feasible for them to provide their facility for such use; and,

WHEREAS, the Potomac Community Center located at 310 W. State St., has agreed to the use of its facility as a polling place for Middlefork Township Precinct 2.

WHEREAS, such combination will result in better safety for Vermilion County taxpayers.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois approves the Potomac Community Center as the new polling place for Middlefork Township.


