WHEREAS, it is vital that this community and every community realize that despite our differences, we are one people, one country, and need to denounce hate and violence as a means of expression; and

WHEREAS, the seed of violence that has taken root must be rejected by all.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by this Board that we extend our sympathies to the victims of this hate, and we unequivocally reject hate and intolerance of any person because of race, religion or personal beliefs and pledge our support for and adherence to the concepts of respect, toleration and civility in all aspects of life so that by our example others may learn the value of such mutual respect and civility.
