

RESOLUTION

RE: PREVAILING WAGE RATE

WHEREAS, the Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130) requires that all laborers, workmen and mechanics employed by or on behalf of any and all public bodies engaged in public works, exclusive of maintenance work, be paid the general prevailing hourly rate as paid for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed; and,

WHEREAS, the Prevailing Wage Act further provides that each public body shall, during the month of June each calendar year, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages in the locality in which work is performed; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Prevailing Wage Act, the Illinois Department of Labor regularly investigates and ascertains the prevailing rate of wages in all localities throughout the State in which work is to be performed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Vermilion County Board of Vermilion County:

Section 1. To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by state, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Vermilion County Board is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing wages for construction work in Vermilion County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Vermilion County Board. *(Note: The State of Illinois has yet to determine or post prevailing wage rates for 2016. The previous year's prevailing wage rates will apply until new rates are posted. Upon posting, the new rates will apply and be duly posted by Vermilion County, Illinois. <http://www.illinois.gov/idol/Laws-Rules/CONMED/Pages/Rates.aspx>)* The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid act shall be the same as in said act.

Section 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Vermilion County Board to the extent required by aforesaid Act.

Section 3. The Vermilion County Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by an interested party in the main office of the Vermilion County Clerk this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

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Section 4. The Vermilion County Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5. The Vermilion County Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6. The Vermilion County Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
