

RESOLUTION

RE: WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR LABORERS' 703 UNIT – JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER

WHEREAS, the Laborers' International Union of North America, AFL-CIO, Local 703, the Chief Judge of the Fifth Judicial Circuit and Vermilion County Juvenile Detention Center, co-employers, were parties to a collective bargaining agreement effective December 1, 2012 through November 30, 2016, and said agreement has expired; and,

WHEREAS, the parties have now reached an agreement which includes wage increases and benefits for the collective bargaining unit employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Laborers' 703 unit membership ratified the agreement for the period of December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, while the County does not sign the collective bargaining agreement, the County funds the budget for each department involved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois, that the County concurs with the ratification of the collective bargaining agreement between the Laborers' 703, the Chief Judge of the 5th Judicial Circuit, and the Juvenile Detention Center and it is therefore appropriate that the Presiding Judge and the Juvenile Detention Center extend the economic wage increases to union employees as set forth in the above mentioned agreement, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference.




