RE: Sale of Tilton Sewer Plant to the Village of Tilton

WHEREAS, the Vermilion County Board is no longer in need of the Tilton Sewer Plant, and

WHEREAS, the value of the land has been established by an appraiser at \$1,500.00 taking into consideration the costs of remediation or other treatment of the remaining structures on site, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Tilton has agreed to accept the site due to its proximity to their property and the Songer Cemetery in exchange for a \$1,500.00 credit towards our sewer bill at the animal shelter.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT:

- A. The County declares the land to be surplus, and
- B. The County of Vermilion for the consideration aforesaid mentioned shall transfer title by quitclaim deed to the Village of Tilton and the Chairman of the Board is authorized to sign such quitclaim deed and deliver the same to the Village of Tilton.
