

RESOLUTION

RE: ABATING ANNUAL TAX LEVY - JAIL EXPANSION AND JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois, in adopting its 2016-2017 Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinances estimated at least \$453,187 in revenue from the one quarter cent public safety tax; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois to expend said sales tax revenues anticipated to be received in lieu of levying a tax approximately eighteen cents per hundred for the purpose of constructing and equipping an addition to the Public Safety Building and a new Juvenile Detention Center, and providing for payment of said bonds, which agreement was entered into pursuant to Section 18 of the Public Building Commission Act, 50 ILCS 20/18; and,

WHEREAS, the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois both levied and indicated its intention to abate the levy of \$453,187 to pay said amounts due to the use of the one quarter cent public safety tax revenues; and,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Vermilion County, Illinois, that the 2016-2017 Annual Tax Levy Ordinance is hereby abated by the reduction of the \$453,187 from the levy for the jail expansion and juvenile detention center projects and the subsequent refunding of such bonds.


