Thank you for becoming a foster care volunteer. Your decision to take an animal into your home to provide a safe, nurturing environment is a tremendous help to the (Organization Name). If you have any questions or if any medical emergency situations develop during your time fostering, please contact us.

If you have any health-related concerns, please contact us as soon as you notice a problem: **DO NOT** wait until a crisis occurs. In the care and treatment of foster animals, there is no such thing as a bad question!

When you call, it will be helpful for us to know:

- 1. Is the animal vomiting?
- 2. Does the animal have diarrhea?
- 3. Is it active or listless?
- 4. Is the animal eating and drinking?
- 5. Lastly, we need the animal's #, name and age.

The following phone numbers are provided as a reference; however, if you need to take an animal to an outside veterinarian, please get permission from your foster care contact person first.
