

RESOLUTION

RE: Microsoft Three Year Contract

WHEREAS, the County of Vermilion has used the services of Microsoft for various computer programs necessary for County operations such as heating and air and door lock programs; and,

WHEREAS, the County can obtain lower rates by signing a contract for a volume licensing agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the agreement calls for a thirty-six-month (36) term and to accept a term above two years to bind the County funds, approval of the Board is required and it is in the best interests of the County and the taxpayer to do so and acquire lower rates; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Vermilion County Board the Vermilion County Board Chairman is authorized to accept and sign agreement with Microsoft for a thirty-six-month term.
