He thanked Mr. O'Toole and the Health Department for all of their hard work during the COVID pandemic, stating to-date there have been 2,788 negative tests, 42 positive & 1 current hospitalization. Budget talks are underway, as Chairman and Erika have aiready met with a few offices and are planning on meeting with more

this month. He explained the audit date has been extended by the state, and ours is almost done so we will meet the deadline. He informed the board of the break-in at the animal shelter Monday night stating that it's currently under investigation. Lastly, he thanked the Danville Police Department and the Vermillon County Sheriff's Department for their hard work this past week.
