RULES OF PROCEDURE 04/02/2013

- 1. Robert's Rules of Order as generally applied in County Board matters and as set out in the County Board Rules of Order will apply. The Chairman will interpret the rules to conduct the hearing in a fair and efficient manner.
- 2. Each resident will have five minutes to present their public comment. Written submissions are welcome and may be dropped off or mailed to the County Board Office, Courthouse Annex, 6 N Vermilion Street, 3rd Floor, Danville, Illinois 61832. Written comments may also be submitted at the time of the meeting.
- 3. As a convenience, any comments delivered to the County Board office by 3:00 PM, April 15th, 2013, will be forwarded to the advisory panel. Written comments are encouraged may also be delivered in person at the public hearing as well.
- 4. Repetitive or cumulative statements made at the public hearing may be limited by the Chairman.
- 5. The Wind Advisory Panel members may ask questions of the participants or may ask for clarification. There will be no debate held at this hearing.
- 6. General written discussions about wind farms or print outs of internet resources will be accepted but not necessarily given weight or consideration. The committee is primarily interested in the views of residents as to the written ordinance itself.
- 7. All participants will abide by rules of civility and proper decorum and may be excluded or ruled out of order if those standards are disregarded.
