Agenda Item 6 – Ordinance- Amendment to the Combined Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Health Department

Motion by Nesbitt, second by Mackiewics for discussion. Public Health Administrator, Doug Toole, explained that most of this budget amendment is due to the COVID situation upon us. The grant money seems to be coming in sooner than expected. We have already used up some of that grant money and expenses are increasing as we utilize additional PPE equipment, postage is increasing due to mailers, we have also had to purchase equipment such as freezers, etc. The contractual line is for improvements to the building such as electrical and replacing some of the older flooring as well as the air conditioning system(s) and heating. They are also looking at getting a large tent which could accommodate a possible drive thru vaccination area. Toole explained that there are two different versions of these grants. One is they give us the money as requested. The other is the Cures grant which is a reimbursable grant. So the money has to be spent first. Then they decide if it is reimbursable. Upon the call of roll, the following members voted yes, to-wit: Nesbitt, Butler, Mackiewicz, Mockbee, and Watson. 5-yes, 2 absent).
