INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

CONTRACT FOR POLICE SERVICES

For and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD and OAKWOOD TOWNSHIP hereby agree as follows:

1. The Village of Oakwood Police shall from the date of this agreement have the authority to perform services and duties within the rural areas comprising Oakwood Township, excluding the Villages of Muncie and Pithian.
2. The Village of Oakwood shall be responsible for the payment of compensation to the Village of Oakwood police officers, and shall be responsible for all liabilities arising as a result of the police officers acting within the scope of their authority within the Village and Township.
3. The Village of Oakwood shall be entitled to receive the proceeds from all fines or assessments collected in connection with any proceeding arising from or related to any ticket or citation or arrest issued or initiated by the Village Police, including the full amount of any share or portion of any such fines or assessment that would be payable to the Township of Oakwood, but for this agreement.
4. The name of Oakwood Township is not to be used on village vehicles or connected in any way to the business of the Village of Oakwood.
5. Any enforcement action requested by Oakwood Township must be agreed upon by both parties. The Village of Oakwood Police are not to establish radar or speed checks outside the Village of Oakwood within the Township of Oakwood however, they hereby have the authority to respond to situations as deemed necessary.
6. Radar and speed checks are permissible on Bronson Rd. and US 150 between the Oakwood village limits west of Oakwood Street and Oakwood Twp. High school, especially on school days and when there are children present, within this agreement.

This agreement is made this 15th day of June, 2021. The contract shall remain in effect until either party chooses to nullify or renegotiate this agreement with written notice to the other party.
