Mr. Chairman,

Attached is a copy of the 2021/2022 budget for the Highway Department's two tax levy funds, County Highway Fund (007) and County Bridge Fund (062). The budget will be presented to the Transportation Committee at the August 10, 2021 meeting.

The proposed tax revenue for the County Highway and County Bridge funds are the same as last year's levels. Both the Highway Fund and the Bridge Fund are levied below the maximum rate allowed. As in recent years, the interest earned on fund balances continue to be small due to historically low interest rates. The projected expenditures for next year in the Highway Fund are \$1,609,694.00, a decrease of 2.20%. The projected expenditures for the Bridge Fund are once again \$380,000.00.

We are in the final year of the contract with the Teamster's Union. This year's budget includes a 3% percent raise for union and non-union employees.

The larger non-recurring items are explained below.

007.810.00.4294 Maintenance/Repair – Buildings

The \$40,000 budgeted in this line item includes funds for rain gutter replacement on part of the building. The gutters collect debris from nearby trees and the design makes it impossible to properly clean them out.

007.810.00.4451 Vehicle Lease/Purchase

This line item is budgeted at \$100,000 and includes the purchase of A.) a 4X4 Class 5 Medium Duty truck cab & chassis to replace our sign truck. It is our intention to re-use the existing utility bed and sign crane. B.) a ¾ ton 4X4 extended cab pick-up truck to replace the oldest truck in our fleet, a 2003.

007.810.00.4452 Equipment Lease/Purchase

This line item is budgeted at \$100,000 and includes the purchase of A.) a small vibratory roller to replace the current one. B.) a 25,000 - 30,000 lb. flat-bed tilting trailer. C.) a 7' x 16' 14,000 lb. dump trailer.

As we approach the final quarter of this current fiscal year (2020-2021) the Highway Fund budget is in overall good shape and I anticipate spending less than the full budgeted amount.

As you look over this year's budget, I am available for any questions you may have.

P E T I T I O N

PETITION OF JAMAICA ROAD DISTRICT, IN VERMILION COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR COUNTY AID TO CONSTRUCT AND REPAIR BRIDGES, CULVERTS, LAND DRAINAGE STRUCTURES.

TO: THE COUNTY BOARD OF VERMILION COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to construct or repair drainage structures over a stream or streams in said Road District for which said Road District is wholly or in part responsible, and,
