

ORDINANCE

RE: APPORTIONMENT OF ELECTION PRECINCTS FOR VERMILION COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR 2022 ELECTION

WHEREAS, current Illinois law, 10 ILCS 5/11-2, effective as of 11/15/2021, requires that the County Board in each county, (except in counties having a population of 3,000,000 inhabitants or over), shall, at its regular meeting in June or an adjourned meeting in July, except for 2021, see below, divide its election precincts so that each precinct shall contain, as near as may be practicable, 1,200 registered voters; and,

WHEREAS, insofar as is practicable, each precinct shall be situated within a single congressional, legislative and representative district and in not more than one County Board district and one municipal ward; and,

WHEREAS, in order to situate each precinct within a single district or ward, the County Board shall change the boundaries of election precincts after each decennial census as soon as is practicable following the completion of congressional and legislative redistricting, *except that, in 2021, the county board shall change the boundaries at a regular or special meeting within 60 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly said deadline being January 14, 2022;* and

WHEREAS, each district shall be composed of contiguous territory in as compact form as can be for the convenience of the electors voting therein; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit "A" contains the proposed changes of precincts showing the old precincts and the new proposed precincts; and

WHEREAS, the new proposed precincts comply with the requirements of the statute and must be completed by January 14, 2022 to be submitted by the County Clerk to the State of Illinois


