Agenda Item 8 – Items of Information Adjournment

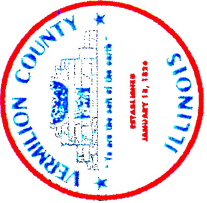

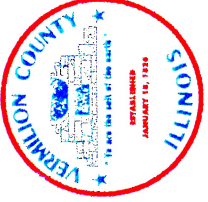

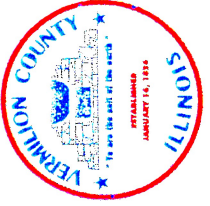
