McLEAN COUNTY WEIGHT LIMIT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is hereby deemed to be of benefit for McLean County to increase the weight limit of Section V – Townline Road, McLean County Highway 24, from the Tazewell County Line (000 East Road) to Illinois Route 122 (400 East Road) to 80,000 pounds; and

NOW THEREFORE, the McLean County Board hereby establishes Section - Townline Road, McLean County Highway 24, from the Tazewell County Line (000 East Road) to Illinois Route 122 (400 East), a distance of 21,542 feet (4.08 Miles), as a Class II Truck Route with an 80,000 pound maximum weight limit. Said designation to be effective upon the completion of the resurfacing of said highway, Section 13-00160-02-RS, and the erection of the signs designating this portion of road as a Class II Truck Route, as herein authorized.



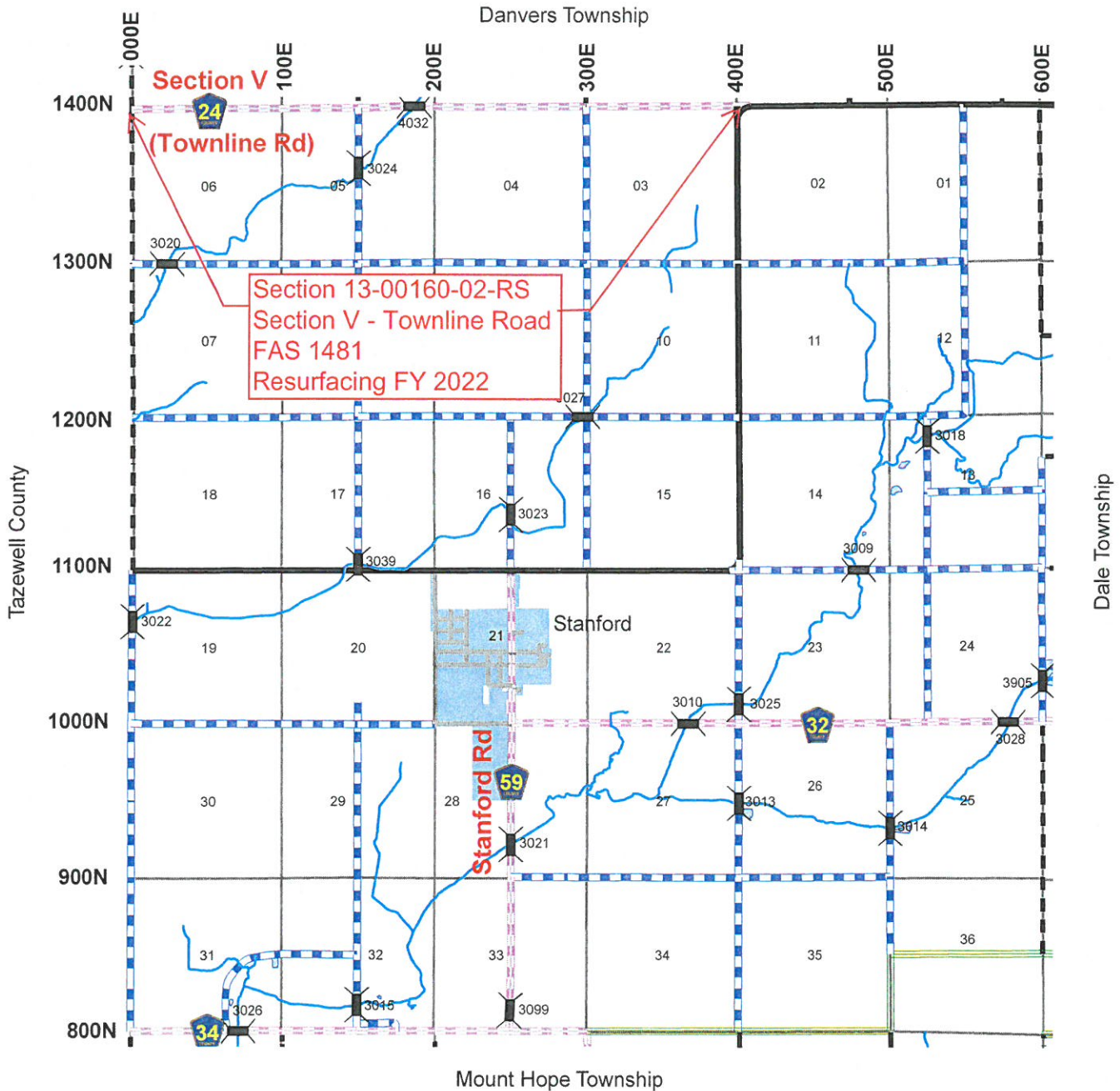

The Illinois Department of Transportation is pleased to inform you that your project has been selected for state fiscal year 2022 Truck Access Route Program (TARP) funding. The project includes improvement to CH 24 from Tazewell County line to IL Rte 22. Congratulations on your successful application.

The state commitment for this project will not exceed \$366,300. The TARP funding will be available after July 1, 2021 provided the Illinois General Assembly appropriates the necessary funding for fiscal year 2022. Every effort should be made to obligate these funds during state fiscal year 2022 which ends June 30, 2022.
