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ADDENDUM

ADDITIONAL PROBATION TERMS and CONDITIONS
MENTAL HEALTH COURT SUPERVISION

The court, having considered the nature and circumstances of Defendant's offense and his/her history, character and condition, and having found the interests of the public and Defendant might be best served by a sentence of probation rather than a sentence of incarceration in the Illinois Department of Corrections or confinement in the Vermilion County Public Safety Building, and having sentenced Defendant to Mental Health Court Probation Supervision based in part upon the availability of a Mental Health Court Supervision Program of the Vermilion County Probation Services Division (Probation Services), Defendant shall follow and comply with all of the following terms and conditions of supervision, which additional terms and conditions, if inconsistent with those found in the Order to which this Addendum has been made a part, control:

1. Defendant shall reside where directed by the Mental Health Court team
2. Defendant shall discuss desired changes in employment with members of the Mental Health Court team prior to any changes.
3. Defendant shall not associate, have any contact, be present, or communicate with in any way, directly or indirectly, any person or persons specified in writing by the Mental Health Court Probation Officer and/or the Mental Health Court team.
4. Defendant shall not be present at any place, business, building, apartment, residence, or other designated location or place, at which his presence has been prohibited in writing by the Mental Health Court Probation Officer and/or the Mental Health Court team.

5. Defendant shall attend and participate in all evaluations, treatment, or counseling programs as may be directed in writing by his/her Mental Health Court Probation Officer and/or the Mental Health Court team. He/She must follow all programs/counseling/treatment rules, regulations, and directions, participate in a respectful, cooperative and constructive manner and complete all requirements. Failure to attend, participate in, and follow all program rules, regulations, and directions is a sufficient basis for a violation of these specialized probationary conditions.
6. Defendant shall cooperate with any and all referrals and attend and participate in all evaluations, assessments, treatment, or counseling programs as directed in writing by the Court, the Mental Health Court team, the Case Manager, the Mental Health Court Probation Officer, Rosecrance, Crosspoint Human Services. He/She must follow all programs/counseling/treatment rules, regulations, and directions, participate in a respectful, cooperative and constructive manner and complete all requirements. Failure to attend, participate in, and follow all program rules, regulations, and directions is a sufficient basis for a violation of these specialized probationary conditions.
7. Defendant shall cooperate with and initiate any directive to seek, obtain, and faithfully maintain suitable, regular, and productive employment and/or attend educational programs whose curriculum is designed to further gainful employment opportunities for him/her, when so directed by the Court, the Mental Health Court team, the Case Manager and/or the Mental Health Court Probation Officer.
8. Defendant shall provide executed forms authorizing the release of information as requested by the Court, the Mental Health Court team, the Case Manager, the Mental Health Court Probation Officer, which shall provide for the full exchange of information between the Case Manager, the Mental Health Court Probation officer, and the Mental Health Court team that is deemed necessary to show progress or compliance with these specialized probationary conditions.
9. Defendant shall perform the required number of public service work hours. He/She shall register with Court Services for assignment of location for public service work hours and shall perform this service at the times and places directed by Court Services and comply with all public service work protocols. He/she shall provide his/her probation officer with written evidence of completion of the public service work at least 90 days prior to the termination of the Mental Health Court program.

10. Defendant shall appear in Courtroom 1B of the Vermilion County Courthouse every Wednesday, beginning with the first Wednesday following the date of this sentence, unless otherwise directed by the Court for purposes of reviewing his/her progress and compliance with these specialized probation conditions.
11. Defendant shall serve 180 days in the Vermilion County Correctional Center. The jail sentencing is stayed pending compliance with Mental Health Court and will be served at the discretion of the Mental Health Court Judge.
12. Any order or directive given Defendant in writing by his/her Probation Officer may only be changed or modified in writing. Any claims by Defendant that he/she had verbal permission from his/her Probation Officer to change, modify, or not follow a written order or directive will be rejected by the court.
13. Defendant is hereby advised the Court may at any time during the period of probation, after a hearing, revoke or modify any term or condition of probation, reduce the period of probation, or discharge Defendant from probation.
