

**INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN
Beth Knecht
AND THE VERMILION COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD
FOR EXPENSES FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID TRAININGS**

This Agreement is between Elizabeth Bray Knecht, located at 823 East Penn St., Hoopeston, IL, 60942 (hereinafter Independent Contractor) and the Vermilion County Mental Health Board, 200 S. College, Suite A, Danville, IL 61832 (hereinafter VCMHB).

WHEREAS Vermilion County, through the County Board and the Independent Contractor have entered into an agreement for Mental Health First Aid Trainings; and

WHEREAS the Independent Contractor is a nationally certified trainer and instructor for the Mental Health First Aid Courses, and who has substantial working knowledge of mental health services in the community, and is ready, willing, and able to provide the Mental Health First Aid Trainings; and

WHEREAS the VCMHB is the fiscal agent for funding from Gibson Area Hospital and Medical Services; and

WHEREAS the VCMHB is authorized to enter into the Agreement under the provisions of the Community Mental Health Act (405 ILCS 201/1, et al).


NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, it is agreed as follows:

ARTICLE A. REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES:

As the Independent Contractor provides Vermilion County with the services and activities agreed upon by contract, the VCMHB will reimburse the Independent Contractor for these allowable expenses with funding from Gibson Area Hospital and Medical Services:

1. Mileage Reimbursement: The rate of reimbursement will be that set by Vermilion County. The Independent Contractor will submit a record of business-related mileage at the end of each month to the VCMHB.
2. Training Supplies: Receipts for purchase of training materials will be submitted on a monthly basis. Purchases must be pre-approved by the VCMHB Executive Director.
