

RESOLUTION

RE: Single Landowner Solar Project – Projects within County Jurisdiction

WHEREAS, the County has been requested to issue a building permit for a Solar Farm project in the County jurisdiction for a project involving a single landowner; and,

WHEREAS, the project developers have complied with all application requirements and State law and now requests the actual issuance of a building permit to the U.S. Solar Oakwood Township project; and,

WHEREAS, the Solar Project consists of a solar farm on a single landowner's property and does not adversely touch upon any County concerns; and,

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the project proposal with the assistance of the the Health Department Administrator, and County Engineer and those individuals find no reason to deny approval of a building permit; and


WHEREAS, the County desires approve the building permit to be signed by the County Board Chairman prior to beginning actual construction of the project.


