

# Getting Started

## Emergency Motion to Claim Exemption

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**IMPORTANT:** This getting started guide and the instructions are not legal advice. They are only meant to help you learn how to file an *Emergency Motion to Claim Exemption*. Your use of the forms does not guarantee you will be successful in court.

To learn how to fill out the forms and file them with the court, read the *How to do an Emergency Motion to Claim Exemption* sheet and the instructions on the forms.

<b>Names of forms:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Emergency Motion to Claim Exemption</i></li> <li>• <i>Notice of Court Date for Emergency Motion to Claim Exemption</i></li> <li>• <i>Order on Emergency Motion to Claim Exemption</i></li> </ul>
<b>Purpose of the forms:</b>	To ask the judge for access to the money in your accounts as soon as possible.
<b>Types of cases the forms CAN be used for:</b>	Cases where a creditor has filed a <i>Citation to Discover Assets to a Debtor's Bank</i> ordering it to freeze your accounts.
<b>Types of cases the forms CANNOT be used for:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cases where your accounts have not been frozen.</li> <li>• Cases where your accounts have been frozen for unpaid child support or taxes.</li> </ul>
<b>Cost to file the forms:</b>	There may be a fee for filing. If you cannot afford to pay the filing fee, you can ask the court to file for free by filing the <i>Application for Waiver of Court Fees</i> found at: <a href="http://www.illinoiscourts.gov/Forms/approved/">http://www.illinoiscourts.gov/Forms/approved/</a>
<b>Special information or papers needed to complete the forms:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The name and address of your bank that has frozen your accounts. You can find this in the <i>Citation to Discover Assets to a Debtor's Bank</i>.</li> <li>• The name and address of the creditor, or the creditor's attorney. You can find this in the <i>Citation to Discover Assets to a Debtor's Bank</i>.</li> </ul>
