Agenda Item 1 and 3 - Call to Order and Roll Call

Committee Chairman Steve Fourez called the Wind and Solar Farm Sub Committee meeting to order at 5:02 P.M. Upon the call of roll, the following subcommittee members were present: Steve Fourez, Adrian Greenwell, Russ Rudd, Harold Puzey, Chris Crawford, and Curt Elmore. 6 present and 0 absent. Also attending the meeting: Guest Speaker Attorney Andrew Keyt from Heyl Royster, Audience Member- Becky Miller, William Donahue - County Board Risk Consultant, Jennifer Jenkins – Vermilion County Board Office Manager.

Agenda Item 4 - Adoption of the Agenda

Rudd moved, second by Elmore, to adopt the agenda. Motion passed by acclamation.

Agenda Item 5 – Approval of Minutes May 8, 2023 meeting

Elmore moved, second by Greenwell, to approve the May 8, 2023 meeting minutes. Motion passed by acclamation.

Agenda Item 6 – Discussion and Action Regarding Ordinance Governing the Siting of Commercial Wind Energy Facilities

Fourez turned the floor over to Attorney Andrew Keyt. Keyt referenced the revised ordinance that was provided along with the agenda. Keyt explained that the suggestions by the committee members were incorporated with the revised version of the ordinance.

Some of those changes suggested were: Table of Contents, Abandoned Mines/Survey Map, Developer to utilize local contractors when able.
