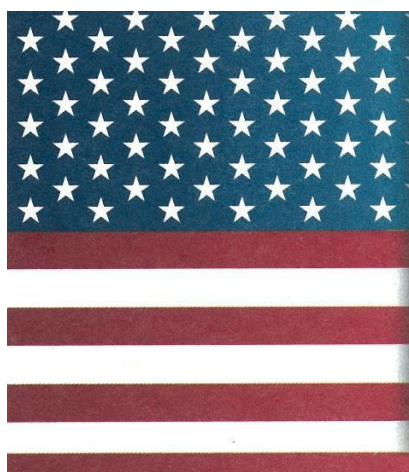

County: County Auditor, Circuit Clerk, County Coroner, County Recorder, State's Attorney & County Board Members. Precinct Committeepersons will be elected in the General Primary Election.
