

WHAT IS EARLY VOTING?

Early Voting is a process that allows any registered voter to cast a ballot prior to Election Day at the Joseph G. Cannon Building, Lower Level, 201 N. Vermilion Street, Danville, Illinois.

Once an Early Vote is cast, it cannot be rescinded. No reason is necessary for voting early. Ballots cast early are tabulated at the Joseph G. Cannon Building, Lower Level on Election Day, by teams of Election Judges (one Democratic and one Republican), after the polls close.
